

Title VI-Related Authorities

- **Federal Transit Administration Circular 4702.1B**
 - **Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987** – No discrimination in entire agency if any part receives federal funds
 - **Executive Order 12898, Environmental Justice** – Identify disproportionate impacts of human health or environmental effects on minority or low-income populations
 - **Governor’s Executive Order No. 41-2008** – Prohibits discrimination in conduct of public service based on ancestry, social origin or condition, culture, etc.
 - **Montana Human Rights Act, Title 49, Chapter 2, Montana Code Annotated-** Prohibits discrimination in specific areas based on race, creed, religion, color, national origin, age, physical or mental handicap, marital status or sex.
