

HIKING + BIKING

1 WATERWORKS HILL TRAILHEAD Located just off Greenough Drive, Waterworks Hill is an easy, scenic in-town hike.

2 FROEHLICH TRAILHEAD

Froehlich Trail and Ridge Trail Loop form a moderately difficult loop for hiking and running.

3 LINCOLNWOOD TRAILHEAD

Providing access to the Rattlesnake National Recreation Area and great for hiking and biking.

4) KIM WILLIAMS NATURE TRAIL

Enjoy hiking and biking on this easy out-and-back path along the Clark Fork River.

5 "M" TRAILHEAD

Short but steep switchback hike up Mount Sentinel to views of the valley and Clark Fork River.

6 MAURICE AVE TRAILHEAD

Additional Mount Sentinel hiking and biking trails including the MoZ Mountain Bike Trail.

"L" TRAILHEAD

Hike up to the "L" on Mount Jumbo or access various nearby hiking and biking trails.

8 SMOKEJUMPERS' TRAIL

Also known as the Hellgate Canyon Trail, this moderate hike leads up the backside of Mount Sentinel.

RIVER ACCESS

9 SHA-RON FISHING ACCESS SITE Boat launch and access site popular for rafting and tubing down the Clark Fork River.

ATTRACTIONS

10 MONTANA MUSEUM OF ART AND CULTURE

MMAC holds the largest and deepest art collection in the state and has rotating and traveling exhibits.

11) BIG SKY BREAKOUT

Missoula's premier escape room experience with themed games for indoor and outdoor fun.

12 HIP STRIP

Located just south of downtown Missoula, featuring unique shops, restaurants, bakeries and a brewery.

13 SPLASH MONTANA

Outdoor water park open June through August with waterslides, a lazy river and an Olympic-size pool.

14 PLAYFAIR PARK

Play baseball, basketball, soccer, tennis and volleyball. Playground equipment and jogging trails.

15 MISSOULA COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

Home to the Western Montana Fair and Glacier Ice Rink and host of events year-round.

16 GLACIER ICE RINK

Offering programs for youth hockey, adult hockey, figure skating, curling and public skating.

17 FORT MISSOULA REGIONAL PARK

Sports complex with a fitness center and 156 acres of playgrounds, fields, picnic shelters and trails.

18 HISTORICAL MUSEUM AT FORT MISSOULA

A 32-acre museum with more than 25,000 objects, including 13 historic structures.

19 ROCKY MOUNTAIN MUSEUM OF **MILITARY HISTORY**

Exhibits and programs covering U.S. military history from the Revolutionary War to the present day.

20 SOUTHGATE MALL

Shopping center and home to more than 90 national and local retail, dining and entertainment options.

21 GIGGLE BOX

Montana's first immersive, experiential art museum with two stories of artwork and creative scenes.



22 UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA

Montana's flagship university with world-class education on a scenic campus. Home to the "Grizzlies."

23 MCCORMICK PARK

Playground, skate park, fishing pond and trail system—all along the banks of the Clark Fork River.

24 CURRENTS AQUATICS CENTER

Indoor water park at McCormick Park with a children's water playground, fitness pool and water

25 MISSOULA PADDLEHEADS

Home to Missoula's Pioneer League baseball team and host to many events throughout the year.

26 MONTANA NATURAL HISTORY CENTER

Provides nature education programming, including museum tours, exhibits and kids' activities.

27 RESERVE STREET BUSINESS DISTRICT Home to a plethora of big box stores, chain restaurants and nationally branded hotels.

28 HUB FAMILY ENTERTAINMENT CENTER Go-karts, arcade games and laser tag on 50,000 square feet of fun and excitement for the whole family.

29 MUSEUM OF MOUNTAIN FLYING

Showcasing the region's mountain flying history including vintage aircraft, memorabilia and artifacts.

30 MISSOULA MONTANA AIRPORT

Offering nonstop flights to 16 major U.S. markets on six airlines and connecting you to the world.

31 A CAROUSEL FOR MISSOULA Fastest carousel in the West and one of the first fully hand-carved carousels in the United States.

32 DRAGON HOLLOW PLAYGROUND Magical play land next to A Carousel for Missoula. Recently expanded for children of all abilities.

33 MISSOULA ART MUSEUM

Leading contemporary art museum featuring Montanan and indigenous exhibits. Free admission

34 ZOOTOWN ARTS COMMUNITY CENTER A local arts center with exhibits, galleries, performances, events and paint-your-own pottery.

35 CARAS PARK

Located in the heart of downtown. Host to markets and events throughout the year.

36 THE WILMA

State-of-the-art concert venue with all the character of a historic 1920s theatre.

37 MCT, INC.

Home to Missoula's Children's Theatre and Missoula Community Theatre.

38 MISSOULA PUBLIC LIBRARY

Missoula's new library with a media resource lab. programs and exhibits for children and more.

39 SPECTRUM DISCOVERY CENTER

Missoula's hands-on science center dedicated to inspiring a culture of learning and discovery for all.

40 MOUNTAIN LINE TRANSFER CENTER

Missoula's community bus service providing zero-fare, fixed-route service in and around Missoula.


DESTINATION Missoula MONTANA


