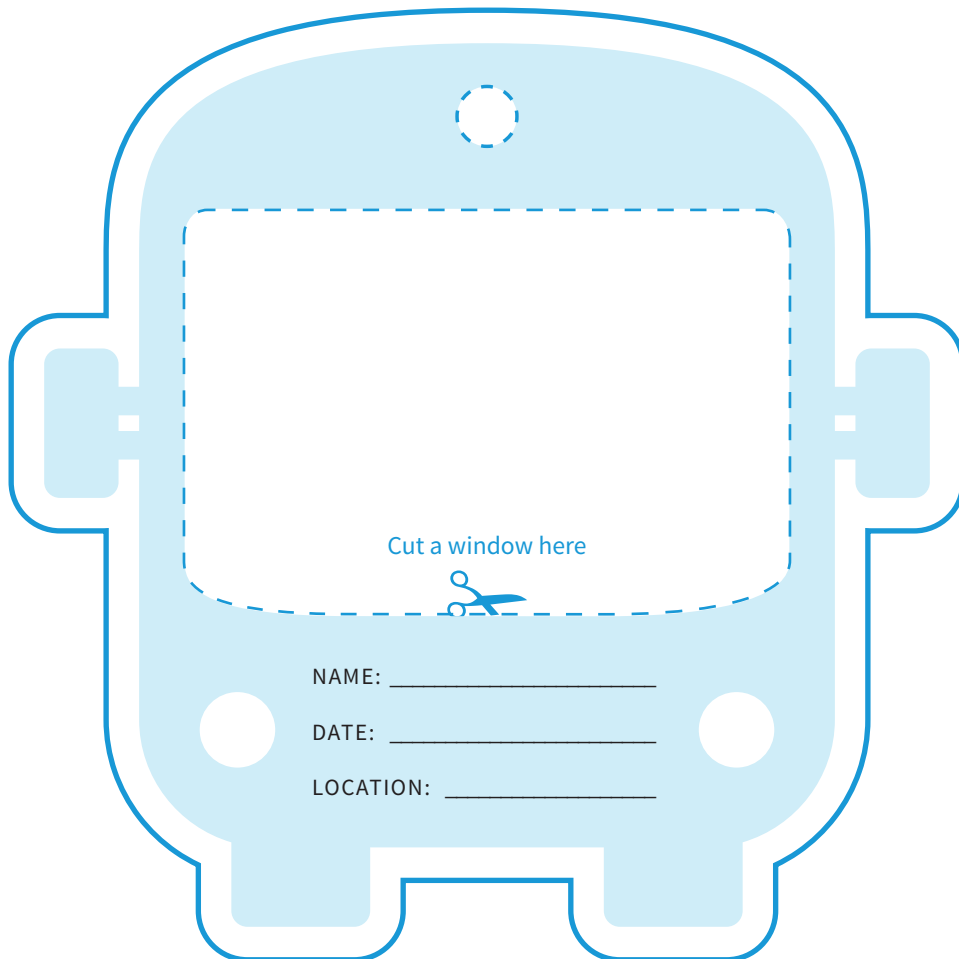




Pollution Collector

1. Cut out your pollution collector from the bus pattern.
 2. Cut a window in the middle of the bus.
 3. Cover the back of the window with a white sticker or strip of packaging tape. The sticky side will face up. Hint: Don't touch the sticky part!
 4. Punch a hole at the top of the collector.
 5. Tie a piece of string through the hole at the top.
 6. Choose a location outside to hang your collector.
 7. Wait a few days. Take down your collector.
 8. Inspect it with a magnifier.
