- 5. Mountain Line update
  - a. Completed first month of 7 day service, ramping up to work first holiday
    (Labor Day)
  - b. Staffing is holding steady, a little lower than ideal but will continue training operators, expected to be fully staffed after next training class.
  - c. Seeing immediate use of Bold Saturday/Sunday service, both fixed route and paratransit. Acknowledged there was a need in the community for evening and Sunday service.
  - d. Close to widespread roll out of paratransit mobile app. Addressing confusion between new Transit app
    - i. How to guide will be sent out to users, guide will be available online

      - 2. Committee asked to provide user feedback on paratransit
    - ii. Accessible vehicles, lack thereof, and extreme costs. Claiming chip shortage, not putting resources into aftermarket vehicles. Will start to affect quality of vehicles. Ford is the only Buy America compliant company to purchase from

- iii. Will there be exceptions from Buy America waiver, purpose built accessible vehicle. Discussions with Canadian company.
- iv. Other partners experiencing the same issues, encourage them to keep in contact with representative from MDT.
- v. Outreach with Students, Sunday Streets, Climate Smart Expo
- vi. MUTD received 10M grant funding for Low/No emissions bus purchasing, will be at 90 electric this decade.
- vii. Jen met with MDT about VA transit stop access, there will eventually be a traffic light at Broadway and Maryjane, work with City to get stop off of Broadway with slight route detour that will increase safety for households and VA. No additional service is anticipated until facility relocation occurs.
