



HIKING + BIKING

1 WATERWORKS HILL TRAILHEAD

Enjoy multiple trails, including an easy, half-mile packed-gravel universal trail with a scenic overlook of downtown Missoula and the Missoula Valley.

2 FROELICH TRAILHEAD

Hike or run the moderately difficult loop formed by Froehlich Trail and Ridge Trail Loop.

3 LINCOLNWOOD TRAILHEAD

Get access to the Rattlesnake National Recreation Area plus great hiking and biking.

4 KIM WILLIAMS NATURE TRAIL

Enjoy hiking and biking on an easy out-and-back path along the Clark Fork River.

5 “M” TRAILHEAD

Hike a short but steep switchback trail up Mount Sentinel for views of the valley and Clark Fork River.

6 MAURICE AVENUE TRAILHEAD

Explore additional Mount Sentinel hiking and biking trails, including the MoZ Mountain Bike Trail.

7 “L” TRAILHEAD

Hike up to the “L” on Mount Jumbo or access various nearby hiking and biking trails.

RIVER ACCESS

8 SHA-RON FISHING ACCESS SITE

Launch boats and access a popular rafting and tubing route on the Clark Fork River. Conservation license required.

ATTRACTIONS

9 UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA GOLF COURSE

Enjoy a round of golf on the nine-hole course or experience unique winter outdoor activities, like cross-country skiing.

10 MONTANA MUSEUM OF ART AND CULTURE

Explore the largest and most robust art collection in the state plus rotating and traveling exhibits in a new building on the UM campus.

11 ROXY THEATER

Discover screenings and events seven days a week, including new releases and a monthly calendar of independent, foreign and classic films, theater and community events.

12 HIP STRIP

Explore unique shops, restaurants, bakeries and breweries just south of downtown Missoula.

13 SPLASH MONTANA

Play at the outdoor water park (June through August) with waterslides, a lazy river and an Olympic-size pool.

14 PLAYFAIR PARK

Play baseball, basketball, soccer, tennis and volleyball and enjoy playground equipment and jogging trails.

15 MISSOULA COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

Attend the Western Montana Fair, Glacier Ice Rink and year-round events.

16 GLACIER ICE RINK

Discover programs for youth hockey, adult hockey, figure skating, curling and public skating.

17 FORT MISSOULA REGIONAL PARK

Enjoy a sports complex with a fitness center and 156 acres of playgrounds, fields, picnic shelters and trails.

18 HISTORICAL MUSEUM AT FORT MISSOULA

Visit a 32-acre historic park with over 20 historic structures that maintains a collection of over 50,000 artifacts.

19 ROCKY MOUNTAIN MUSEUM OF MILITARY HISTORY

Explore exhibits and programs covering U.S. military history from the Revolutionary War to present day. The museum is open June - Labor Day.

20 SOUTHGATE MALL

Visit a shopping center that’s home to more than 90 national and local retail, dining and entertainment options, including an AMC theater.

21 LOOKOUT THROWING CO.

Enjoy Montana’s original indoor axe throwing facility with six throwing bays comfortably accommodating up to eight guests per bay.

22 UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA

Check out Montana’s flagship university with world-class education on a scenic campus. Home to the “Grizzlies.”

23 GET AIR TRAMPOLINE PARK

Bounce on over to Missoula’s trampoline park! Get Air is perfect for birthday parties, team sports events, corporate gatherings, family fun and more.

24 MCCORMICK PARK

Explore an all-abilities playground, skate park, fishing pond and access the riverfront trail system along the Clark Fork River.

25 CURRENTS AQUATICS CENTER

Enjoy an indoor water park at McCormick Park with a children’s water playground, fitness pool and water slides.

26 OGREN PARK

Catch a game and events throughout the year at Ogren Park, home to Missoula’s Pioneer League baseball team the Paddleheads.

27 MONTANA NATURAL HISTORY CENTER

Participate in nature education programming, including museum tours, exhibits and activities for kids.

28 RESERVE STREET BUSINESS DISTRICT

Discover a plethora of big box stores, chain and local restaurants and nationally branded hotels.

29 MISSOULA BUTTERFLY HOUSE & INSECTARIUM

Experience tropical butterflies and other exhibits featuring live insects from around the world.

30 MUSEUM OF MOUNTAIN FLYING

Discover the region’s mountain flying history, including vintage aircraft, memorabilia and artifacts. The museum is open Memorial - Labor Day.

31 MISSOULA MONTANA AIRPORT

Get access to nonstop flights to 14 major U.S. markets on six airlines connecting you to the world.

32 LARCHMONT GOLF COURSE

Tee up at an immaculate 18-hole championship golf course located in the heart of the Missoula valley.

33 A CAROUSEL FOR MISSOULA

Have fun at the fastest carousel in the West and one of the first fully hand-carved carousels in the U.S.

34 DRAGON HOLLOW PLAYGROUND

Explore a magical play land next to A Carousel for Missoula. Recently expanded for children of all abilities.

35 MISSOULA ART MUSEUM

Visit the leading contemporary art museum featuring Montanan and Indigenous exhibits. Free admission for all.

36 ZOOTOVN ARTS COMMUNITY CENTER

Enjoy exhibits, galleries, performances, events and paint-your-own pottery.

37 CARAS PARK

Explore the lively markets and events in the heart of downtown Missoula.

38 THE WILMA

Experience a state-of-the-art concert venue with all the character of a historic 1920s theatre.

39 MCT, INC.

Take in live theater performances by Missoula Children’s Theatre and Missoula Community Theatre.

40 MISSOULA PUBLIC LIBRARY

Visit Missoula’s state-of-the-art library—voted the World’s Best Library—with a media resource lab, programs and exhibits for children, and more.

41 SPECTRUM DISCOVERY CENTER

Explore Missoula’s hands-on science center (located in the library) dedicated to inspiring a culture of learning and discovery for all.

Ride Missoula’s community bus service, providing zero-fare, fixed-route service in and around Missoula.

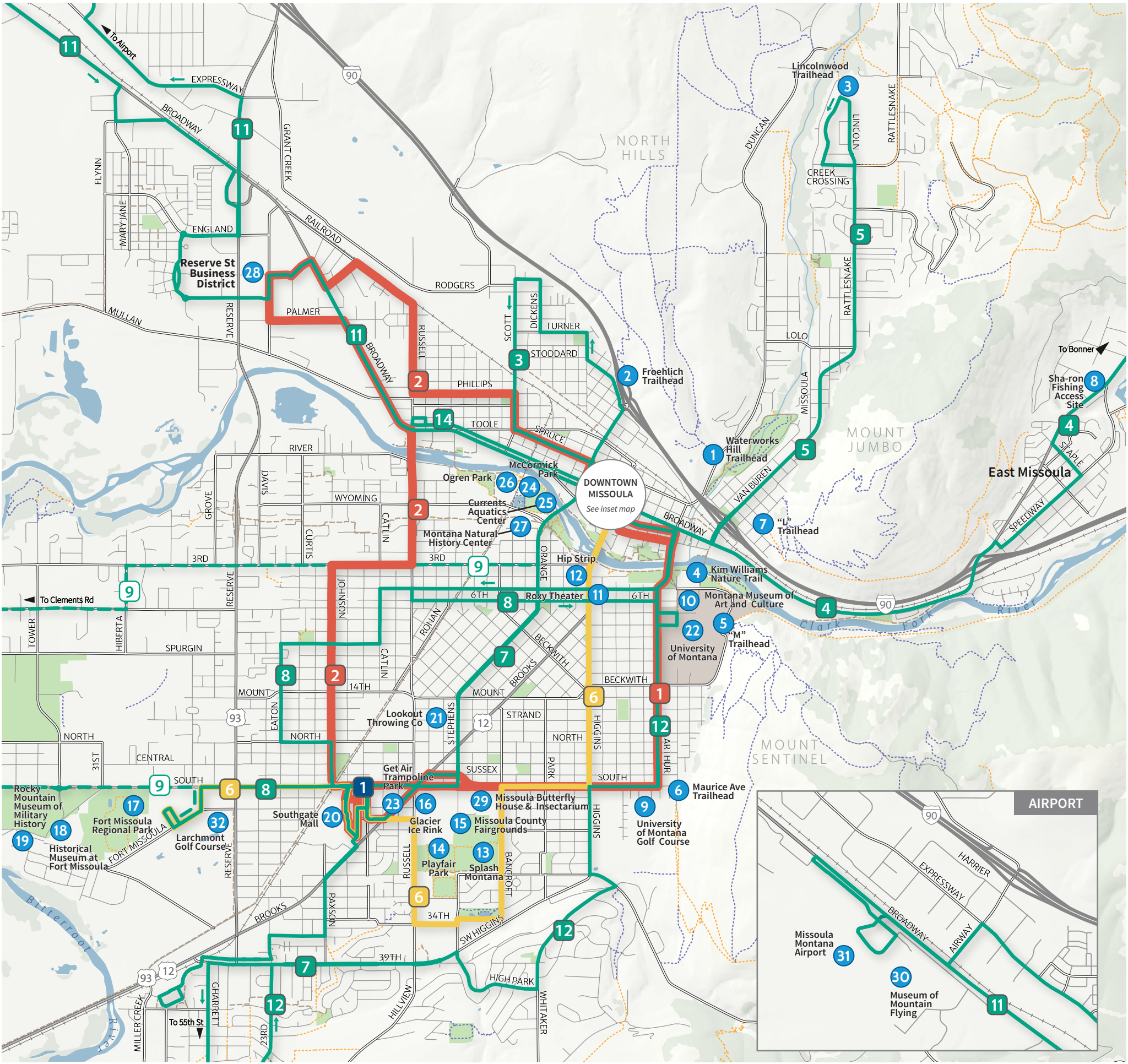
