Recommendation:

Adopt a policy governing petitions for removal from the MUTD district.

Discussion:

On May 8, 2025, Governor Greg Gianforte signed HB 764 into law. HB 764 revised various laws related to urban transportation districts, including the requirements for petitioning for removal from an urban transportation district. HB 764 takes effect on October 1, 2025. The board of directors needs to update its processes for consideration of petitions for removal to reflect the requirements of HB 764.

Financial Impact and Funding Source:

Removal of property or properties from the urban transportation district depletes district revenues. The actual amount varies depending on the factual circumstances of the petition for removal.
